### « China's Marine Economic Development Strategies and opportunities for international cooperation: general perspectives and cases from Qingdao »

#### **Abstract**

China has promised to upgrade its marine economic strategy in recent decade. A series of national policies on marine industries and coastal regions have been carried out since 2009. But the initiatives of extensive marine development projects has brought about abuse of limited marine resources and pollution of marine environment. The international cooperation programs on marine economies have encountered some problems under sluggish economic growth and shortages of liquidity worldwide. Qingdao has been regarded as the leading marine city in China, mainly based on its marine science and technology research institutes agglomeration. The Blue Silicon Valley project in Qingdao Eastern Suburb has been planned as the internationally competing complex in pushing forward marine emerging industries in China. Although striving efforts have been made by local policy makers, it is still hard to say that ideal models have been established in attracting marine innovation stakeholders from global marine research and industrial centers.
